Harry Potter y la piedra filosofal, llamado también Harry Potter o abreviado HP1 (título original en inglés Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone, excepto en Estados Unidos, donde se tituló Harry Potter and the Sorcerer's Stone), es el primer libro de la serie literaria Harry Potter, escrito por la autora británica J. K. Rowling, en 1997 que supuso además el debut de Rowling como escritora profesional. La novela presenta a Harry Potter, un niño huérfano criado por sus tíos que descubre en su undécimo cumpleaños que es un mago. En la novela se narran sus primeros pasos en la comunidad mágica, su ingreso en el Colegio Hogwarts y cómo comienza a hacer amigos, que lo ayudan a enfrentarse a lord Voldemort, el brujo tenebroso que había

asesinado a sus padres y cuyo espíritu busca un antiguo objeto legendario conocido como la piedra filosofal. La novela fue rechazada por varias editoriales hasta que la editorial Bloomsbury se decidió a publicarla. La edición británica salió a la venta el día 30 de junio de 1997,2 seguida en Estados Unidos el 1 de septiembre de 1998 por la edición de Scholastic Corporation. La Editorial Salamandra obtuvo en el año 2000 los derechos para la publicación del libro en castellano. En el año 2007, una primera edición firmada por Rowling se subastó en Londres por 27.876 libras. Además, ese mismo año se comercializó una edición conmemorativa de la novela. Harry Potter y la piedra filosofal ganó diversos premios literarios en el Reino Unido y en los Estados Unidos; en agosto de 1999, llegó a la cima de la lista best-sellers de ficción que aparece en el periódico The New York Times quedando entre los primeros puestos del listado durante la mayor parte de los años 1999 y 2000. Junto con el resto de la serie de Harry Potter, este volumen ha recibido las críticas de varios grupos religiosos y ha sido prohibido en algunos países debido a acusaciones de promover la brujería. Sin embargo, algunos comentaristas cristianos han escrito que el libro ejemplifica importantes conceptos valorados por la doctrina cristiana, incluido el poder de auto-sacrificio y la forma en que las decisiones de las personas forman su personalidad. Se han realizado varias adaptaciones de la novela, que incluyen audiolibros, videojuegos y un largometraje estrenado en 2001. La película basada en el libro contó con la dirección de Chris Columbus y se convirtió en una de las películas más taquilleras en la historia del cine.
